



STRAIGHT TALK PROGRAM: My To Do Checklist

- Custodial parent or legal guardian must attend with their child(ren) for the entire program. Siblings or other related youth may also attend for education if they are more than 8 years old.
- Classes are held at: University of Michigan Hospital, 1500 E. Medical Center Dr., Ann Arbor, MI in the Ford Auditorium (University Hospital 2nd Floor). See below for driving and parking instructions, and helpful wayfinding photos.
- You have 2 parking options:
 - 1) Free: Park in Parking Structure “P2” located on E. Medical Center Drive next to the Main Entrance circle drive for University Hospital (UH)/Taubman Center. Keep your ticket and we will provide you with a voucher during the program.
 - 2) Costs you \$5: Valet parking is available at the main entrance of UH/Taubman Center.
- Allow extra driving time for delays from traffic, construction, parking, or weather. *Plan ahead, as late arrivals will not be allowed into the program.*
- Registration begins at 9:15 a.m. on the day of the class.** You must check-in by 9:50 a.m. at the Ford Auditorium Lobby, located on the 2nd floor of University Hospital. See the following pages for detailed wayfinding maps.
- Plan for the program to last until 4:00 p.m.
- Lunch: Bring your own lunch, or money to use the on-site food services (full-service cafeteria, Einstein Bros. Bagels, or vending machines). There will not be time to leave the building for lunch.
- Proof of Completion: You will receive a certificate at the end of the class. It is your responsibility to give it to the referring agency or probation officer.
- Straight Talk is provided for free to you through generous gifts. After the program, please help us thank our donors by providing feedback or testimonies.



STRAIGHT TALK PROGRAM RULES



- 1. Custodial parent(s) or legal guardian must attend with the child for the entire program. Siblings or other related youth may also attend for education if they are more than 8 years old.**
2. No lighters, matches, computers, reading material, headphones, or weapons of any kind will be allowed. Cell phones, pagers, and other mobile devices must be silenced or shut off during the class.
3. No eating or drinking will be allowed in the auditorium.
4. The University of Michigan Health System will not be responsible for any lost or damaged property.
5. Minors must be accompanied by parent/legal guardian at all times during the program.
6. Please be respectful of the program time schedule. Late arrivals will not be permitted to enter once program is in session.
7. **THIS PROGRAM WILL NOT BE RESCHEDULED.** Cancellations and/or failure to attend the entire program are considered a violation of the program terms. No certificate will be given.
8. Participants are to wear appropriate clothing, such as what they wear to school or work.
- 9. Uncooperative or disruptive behavior will not be tolerated and may result in the child and adult being removed from the program.**

We agree to abide by the above rules and understand that failure to comply will result in removal from the program.

How Do I Get to the University of Michigan Hospital?



From the North: Take **US-23** South, to downtown Ann Arbor, **Exit 3**. Turn right onto Main St. Proceed about 0.7 of a mile to the first light and turn left onto Depot St. Follow Depot St. until it becomes Fuller St. (you will see the Health System campus on your right). At the traffic light, turn right onto Maiden Ln./East Medical Center Dr.

From the South: Take **US-23** North to Geddes Rd., **Exit 39**. Turn left onto Geddes Rd. and continue for approximately 2 miles. Geddes Rd. becomes Fuller St. after the Huron Parkway intersection. Continue on Fuller St. for another 2 miles. You will pass the Veterans Hospital and see the Health System campus to your left. Turn left at the traffic light at Fuller St. and Maiden Ln./East Medical Center Dr.

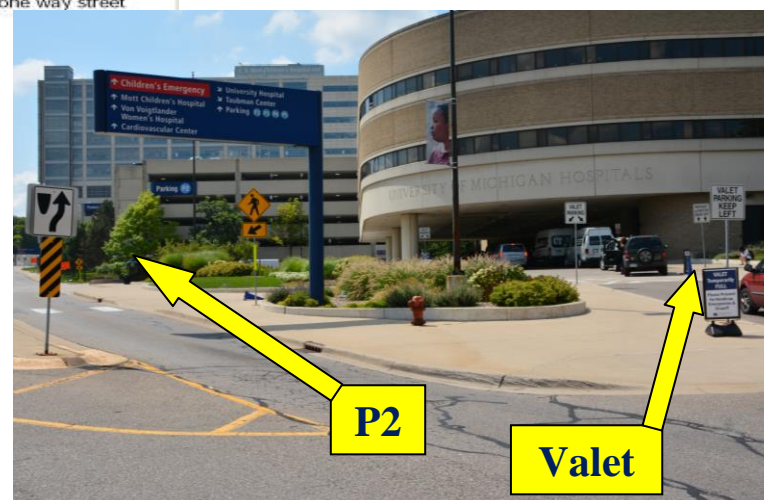
From the East: Take **I-94** West to **US-23** North, **Exit 180B**. From **US 23** take Geddes Rd. **Exit 39** and turn left. Continue on Geddes Rd. for about 2 miles. Geddes Rd. becomes Fuller St. after the intersection at Huron Parkway. Continue on Fuller St. for another 2 miles. You will pass the Veterans Hospital and see the Health System campus to your left. Turn left at the traffic light at Fuller St. and Maiden Ln./East Medical Center Dr.

From the West: Take **I-94** East to Ann Arbor, **Exit 172**. This merges on to Jackson Rd. (Eastbound). Remain on Jackson Rd., which becomes Huron St., and continue for 2.5 miles through downtown. At the traffic light at Glen St. and Huron St., turn left onto Glen St. You will see the Health System campus on your right. At the traffic light, turn right onto Maiden Ln./East Medical Center Dr.

Where Do I Park?

Follow E. Medical Center Dr. past the Adult Emergency Department. The UH Main Entrance **Valet Parking (\$5)** or **Parking Structure P2 (free)** is up the hill on the right.

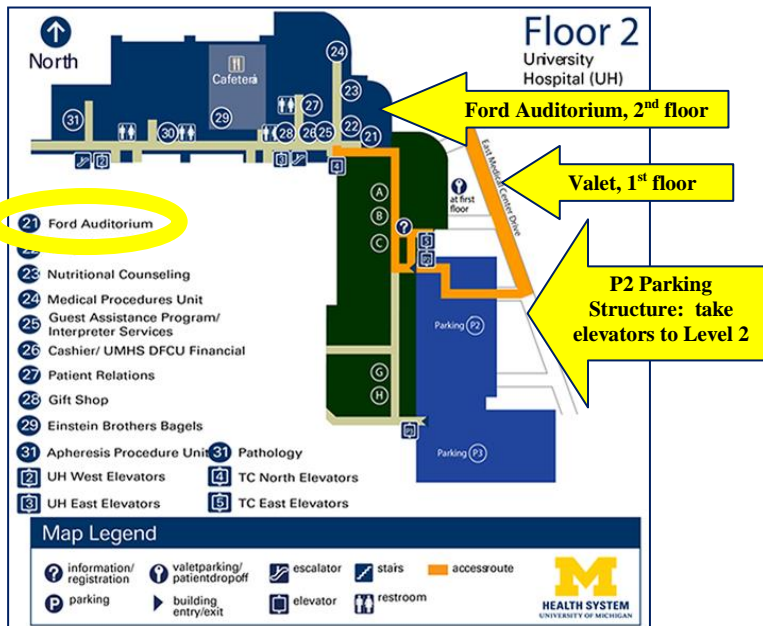


P2 Parking Structure

Ford Auditorium Lobby: Located on the 2nd floor of University Hospital (directions below)



If you get lost or need help

Call Kristy Brown at 734-936-6266, then enter pager ID 31744#. Or ask for directions at the Welcome Center Desk on the 1st floor (by the front entrance of the main hospital UH/ Taubman Center).

From the P2 Parking Structure: Take the North elevators to the 2nd floor (Level 2). Enter hospital door and turn right. Follow the long hallway, turn left at the end, and then take a right by the elevators. See the map above and photos below.



From Valet Parking (or 1st Floor Hospital Entrance): Enter through main entrance revolving doors and turn right. Proceed past Welcome Center desk towards University Hospital. Use the East Escalator (or elevators) to get to the 2nd floor. Turn right, and Ford Auditorium is located at the end of the hallway. See the map above or photos below.
